ON THE VERGE OF REVOLT.:The Anti-Magyar Agifation in Croatia Dangerously Warm. The Washington Post Sep 9, 1883. pg. 4, 1 pgs, AGRAM, Sept. 8. -- An anti-Magyar mob assembled here last evening and smashed the windows of the government offices on which the Hungarian escutcheon had been yesterday replaced. The troops were ordered out by Baron von Ramberg, the military commander, and the rioters were dispersed at the point of the bayonet.
