He succeeded Mr. Clark allen who was Gleichen's first telephone trouble shooter. In 1921 he married toA alic Ramberg and they had one son, Bob, born in 1922, who is now a director with consolidated mines in montreal. the telephone men in those days as well as now were called on to work longhours in an emergency. In April 1932, there was a heavy sleet storm and all local phones, as well as night and day and communications were restored in about a week. AroundG gleichen district some rural lines were not re-installed till some years later. Louis died in Calgary in 1950. Alice is now Mrs. Les Reid and resides at High River.
2. *Obituary*, Ludwig (Louis) H. Sather, 71, of 309- Devenish Apts. died Wednesday in Holy Cross Hospital. The funeral service will be conducted Saturday at 1:30 p.m. in Gooder Bros. funeral home. Burial will be in Queen's Park Cemetery. Mr. Sather was born in Kongsvinger, Norway and came to Edmonton in 1909. He lived in Gleichen from 1921-1936 then moved to Lethbridge where he lived until 1940. From 1940-1944 when he moved to Calgary. He farmed in DeWinton. He was employed with the Alberta Government Telephones for 30 years prior to his retirement in 1940 and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of North America. Surviving are his wife Alice, of Calgary; a son, Robert of Rossland, B.C.; 2 grandchildren; a sister in the United States and 2 sisters and 3 brothers in Norway.
